

Holiday Fire Safety Checklist for Homeowners

1. INSPECT HOLIDAY LIGHTS

- ☐ Check cords for frays, cracks, or exposed wires, and replace any damaged strings.
- ☐ Make sure sockets are intact with no broken or missing bulbs.
- ☐ Use LED lights instead of traditional lights to reduce heat and fire risk.
- ☐ Position lights away from flammable materials like curtains or furniture.
- ☐ Unplug lights before leaving home or going to bed.

2. SAFETY USE CANDLES

- ☐ Place candles on stable, heat-resistant surfaces, away from flammable materials like curtains, bedding, or holiday decorations.
- ☐ Use battery-operated candles whenever possible.
- ☐ Never leave candles burning unattended, especially around pets or children.

3. CHRISTMAS TREE PRECAUTIONS
☐ Position the tree at least three feet away from fireplaces, radiators, or space heaters.
☐ Keep live trees watered daily to prevent them from drying out.
☐ Avoid decorating with real, lit candles on or around the tree.
4. TEST SMOKE AND CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS
☐ Test all smoke and carbon monoxide detectors monthly.
☐ Replace batteries as needed and ensure detectors are installed on every level of the home.
5. FIREPLACE SAFETY
☐ Schedule a professional cleaning for the chimney to remove creosote buildup.
☐ Always use a screen to prevent sparks from escaping.
☐ Dispose of ashes in a metal container kept outside, away from any flammable surfaces.
6. FIRE INSURANCE AND CODE COMPLIANCE
\square Position the tree at least three feet away from fireplaces, radiators, or space heaters.
\square Keep live trees watered daily to prevent them from drying out.
☐ Avoid decorating with real, lit candles on or around the tree.
